He subsequently served as Marketing Director and Head of Products for Digicel’s Dutch Caribbean operations and previously held product and operations leadership positions at Orange UK. He has also founded technology ventures spanning process automation, artificial intelligence and advertising within telecommunications. His combination of regional operating experience, technology development and entrepreneurship is expected to support Kintyre as the Group builds and commercialises its technology capabilities.



Christopher “Chris” Denny joins the Board as a Director and Chair of the Audit Committee. Denny has been appointed as a Director and Chair of the Audit Committee, bringing more than two decades of banking, capital markets and executive leadership experience to the role. His career includes senior positions as Vice President at Victoria Mutual Building Society, Vice President at Citigroup, Managing Director of Citifinance Limited, and Director of Retail, Wealth & Small Business Banking at FirstCaribbean International Bank in Jamaica, where he led a 350-person division regulated by the Bank of Jamaica and the Financial Services Commission. He has also held senior roles at NCB, Knutsford Capital Merchant Bank and Dehring Bunting & Golding and has traded on the floor of the Jamaica Stock Exchange. Since 2011, Denny has served as Founder and Managing Director of CariBEE, with a focus on sales, public speaking, customer experience and leadership training. He also currently serves on the Board of JETS, including its Finance and Compensation Committees. His experience is expected to further strengthen Kintyre’s financial reporting, internal controls and audit readiness.

Commenting on the appointments, Tyrone Wilson, Chairman, President & CEO of Kintyre Holdings, said: “The appointments of Jahmar, Neil and Chris bring valuable and complementary expertise to the Kintyre Board at an important stage in our development.
